11	Can funds be used to build or renovate homes for Veterans?	<p><i>In the RFA, Part 2: Grant Project Information, Section A.</i></p> <p>Homeless/Housing: <i>This category includes homeless support programs, shelter, transitional living/temporary housing, at-risk homeless prevention and rapid re-housing programs. <u>It does NOT include construction of housing.</u></i></p> <p>Adaptive assistance and renovation is allowed under this grant.</p>
12	When filling the grant on the budget table page 13 of 15 states that <u>The total of Table K MUST match the grant amount being requested.</u> After all numbers are posted, our calculation after the 7% of indirect cost is applied (we have an indirect cost agreement with the Federal government) is \$74,962. We are requesting \$75,000. It is the amount close enough? or we should match it to \$75,000.	<p><i>In the RFA, IV. Program Guidelines, C. Funding Amounts and Financial Documentation, the applicant must choose 1 amount and the total in Table K must match the amount requested.</i></p> <p>In this case, your budget must match \$75,000.</p>
13	When we were writing the grant, should we double click in the gray boxes and write inside or we may write outside the gray boxes? This is because the allowable words in the gray boxes are limited. We need sufficient words to describe some areas.	<p><i>In the Appendix I-The Application:</i></p> <p><i>All information must be in sufficient detail to ensure the project can be weighed with other proposals. Do not exceed word maximums.</i></p> <p>Word maximums are listed in the Application in each section. An applicant can click in the gray box or write outside the gray boxes as long as the word maximums are not exceeded.</p>
