21	Can a home that is owned by a non-profit be remodeled to become a veteran's group home be eligible for this grant?	See Addendum I, Question #2. <i>Part 2: Grant Project Information</i> <i>Section A.</i> Homeless/Housing: <i>This category includes homeless support programs, shelter, transitional living/temporary housing, at-risk homeless prevention and rapid re-housing programs. <u>It does NOT include construction of housing.</u></i> Adaptive assistance and renovation is allowed under this grant.
22	We have upward of 125 agencies that are available to see that xxxx is successful in its performance of this project. Do you want ALL agencies that will work with xxxx in serving veterans on this project?	Part 1: Organization Information Section C Partnerships Partnership agencies or organizations may be used by the organization to deliver the services of the proposed project. List those agencies that will work with the Eligible Applicant to provide the services and/or program that will be funded by this grant. <u>Do not list partner agencies that are not affiliated with the proposed project.</u>
23	In the grant application, Part 5, Budget Narrative, it states the required content for the budget narrative and limits that content to 500 words maximum. After that paragraph and after the word limit declaration (but within Part 5), there is a line below that states, "Additionally, discuss the following if applicable" and it asks for information about other funding sources, determination of beneficiary need and how need will be met,	Part 5: Budget Narrative The entire budget narrative should not exceed 500 words.

24	Is it allowable to furnish bills for service from an outside agency (i.e. a community substance abuse treatment program) that have not yet been paid in full in order to receive reimbursement?	<p>XI. Reporting Requirements and Applicable Regulations and Statutes</p> <p><i>Applicants with funded projects are required to submit expenditures monthly and quarterly performance reports.</i></p> <p>No. Expenditure reports must include supporting payment detail. Reimbursements are for the amount of allowable paid expenditures.</p>
25	On page 10 of 14, I am having problems with Table A. When I click on it, it opens up like a picture. Table B on the same page opens up like an Excel Spreadsheet and is easy to work with. Any suggestions?	The application can be re-downloaded from the FVA website.

Indicate which principals are Veterans.</i></p> <p>Dependent on the organization, the governing body, managers, etc. may be involved in the day-to-day running of the project for which funding is requested.</p>
27	For Part 2, C Project Summary on the application. Are we allowed to provide services to our clients from more than one of the bullets under "Purpose and Overview" (as stated on page 3 of the RFA). For example can our agency provide services for "Employment, training, education, and job placement assistance" and "Family and/or individual counseling for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)"?	<p>Part 2: Grant Project Information</p> <p>A.
