Veterans and Active Duty Personnel Get Help at Benefits Fair

WICHITA FALLS – Military veterans and active duty personnel will get help with employment, disability compensation, education, home and land loans, and other state and federal benefits at a free Benefits Fair on February 20, 2010.

The Benefits Fair is open to all Veterans, Active Duty Personnel currently serving in the Armed Forces and their families. The Texas Veterans Commission, Veterans Land Board, U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs, Small Business Administration, other federal and state agencies as well as nonprofit organizations will have professionals on hand to answer questions.

“Active service members separating from the military in the next 60 to 90 days need to have their medical documentation, employment information and other paperwork ready now, so they can get their benefits once they separate,” said Duncan McGhee, Director of Marketing and Training for the Texas Veterans Commission. “This Benefits Fair is a great place to learn what steps to take now to take care of themselves and their families later.”
