The Request for Applications window for the 2025-2026 grant cycle will open at 5PM (CST) on September 12th, 2024.

The Fund for Veterans' Assistance will accept applications for the 2025-2026 grant year from Thursday September 12th starting at 5PM (CST) through Tuesday November 12th until 5PM (CST). Stay tuned to this page and the resources provided to help your organization through the upcoming grant cycle!

Every year, the Commission encourages eligible charitable organizations, local government agencies, and Veteran Service Organizations with veteran-specific programs and services to apply for grant funding during the application window.

All applications must be timely submitted electronically through the [Grants Portal \(Fluxx\)](#). No paper applications or other methods of submission will be considered for funding.

2024-2025 GRANTS AWARDED

The Texas Veterans Commission announced the Fund for Veterans' Assistance grant recipients on May 16, 2024 during their FY24 3rd Quarter Commission Meeting.

For the upcoming grant period (July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025), there were 181 grants awarded, totaling \$44,207,000. The 2024-2025 TVC grant recipients are projected to provide direct services to 41,987 veterans, their dependents, and surviving spouses.

Moderators – Organization Account Administrator

Moderators

The new system is designed to have specific "moderators" for each organization. The moderator is essentially an account administrator who will have the ability to add additional users from the organization. **You are allowed (and encouraged) to have two moderators - a primary and secondary.** They will have the exact same privileges in the system.

To prepare for your account registration, identify who within your organization will serve as the primary and secondary moderator. The first person to register is the primary moderator and the next person who registers is the secondary moderator. One moderator is acceptable, but having two is encouraged in case the first is not available or leaves the position.



Your moderators will be the people who:

- Initiate the registration in the new system
- Complete registration and ensure organizational profile information is accurate
- Identify/create additional users for your organization
- Create the application based on the opportunity - grant program and service category



Grant writers, contractors, and temporary staff should NOT click on "Apply for Funding" or "Submit" funding applications as this should only be done by a moderator.

Moderators can add additional users to the system. They are the only ones who have this privilege.

Create Login for Additional Users

If a particular role is shared by multiple individuals, you must establish a primary person for that role and select them from the drop-down list as required.

There is no cap on the number of people profiles that are allowed but there must be at least one moderator.

When deciding which additional users to add, keep the following in mind:

Additional users may include (but is not limited to):

- Chief Executive Officer
- Chief Financial Officer
- Grant Manager
- Grant Accountant
- Media/Communications Coordinator

There are five account types required for the registration process and it is recommended that you establish these roles internally and create these profiles BEFORE you begin a grant application. *Note that one person can fulfill multiple roles.* These required roles are:

- Executive Director
- Chief Financial Officer
- Project Manager/Coordinator
- Project Accountant
- Media/Communications Coordinator

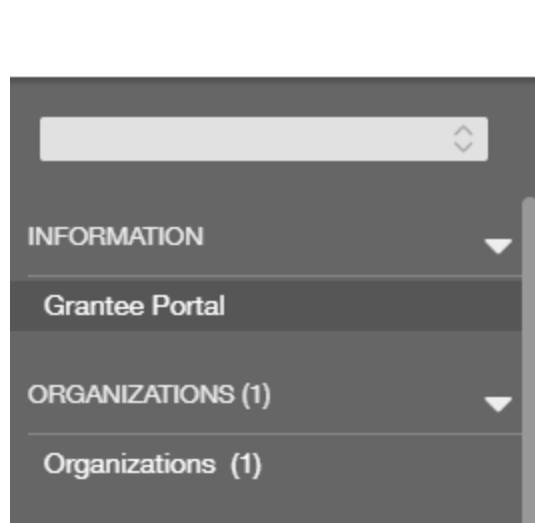

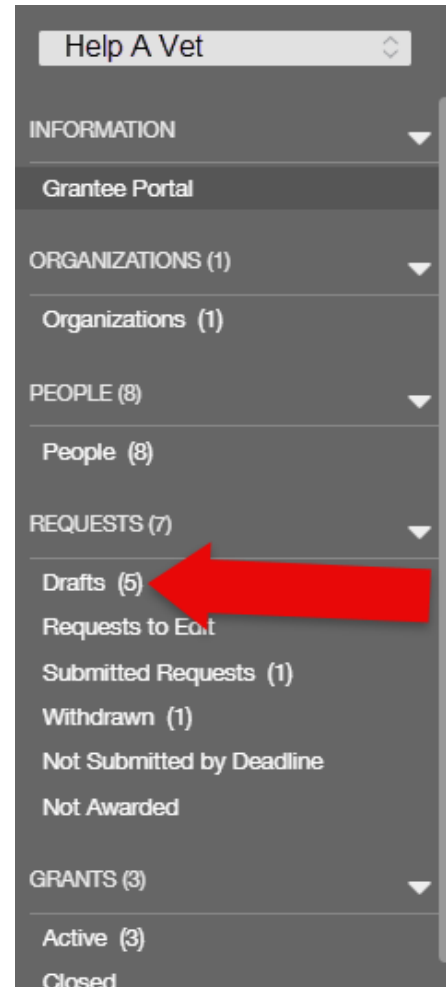
