Every year, the Commission encourages eligible charitable organizations, local government agencies, and Veteran Service Organizations with veteran-specific programs and services to apply for grant funding during the application window. All applications must be timely submitted electronically through the [Grants Portal \(Fluxx\)](#). No paper applications or other methods of submission will be considered for funding.

The Request for Applications window for the 2025-2026 grant cycle is open from September 12th, until 5PM CST November 12th 2024.

The Fund for Veterans' Assistance will accept applications for the 2025-2026 grant year from Thursday September 12th starting at 5PM (CST) through Tuesday November 12th until 5PM (CST). Stay tuned to this page and the resources provided to help your organization through the upcoming grant cycle!

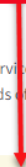
Eligibility To Apply For TVC Grants

Is your organization eligible to apply for a grant from the Fund for Veterans' Assistance?

Eligible to Apply are:

- Organizations providing services under a renewed grant are not eligible for a second renewal and must apply under this RFA for the 2025-2026 grant period.
- Units of local government.
- IRS Code §501(c)(19) Posts or organizations of past or present members of the Armed Forces.
